

Howard County REACT Assists with Vaccination Clinic

On January 29th, our team received a last-minute request to assist with traffic control for the Howard County Health Department's COVID-19 vaccination clinic, set to take place the very next day. While the health department had been operating the clinic the entire week prior without issue, several factors led them to believe they would need additional help. These factors

included the fact that it was a Saturday and an incoming winter storm was forecast for Sunday and Monday meant they would have to push those appointments up sooner. Given these factors, this also meant the number of vaccinations to be given out was almost 4 times greater than they had originally planned, making the request for additional volunteers a wise one. With just a half days' notice, our team along with other COAD (Community Organizations Active in Disaster) members were able to provide 10 volunteers, covering 3 shifts throughout the day.

While the clinic did run a little beyond the expected end time and traffic did become a slight issue; in particular, vehicles blocking the entrance to Howard Community College where the clinic was being administered.

Our team and the other COAD members were able to adapt and handle the additional challenges that were thrown our way. As such, the clinic was an overall success and was able to deliver over 2200 vaccinations in one day!

May she Rest In Peace.




William Gillham 1952-2020

SILENT MIC DEONANAN "KENNY" JAGDEOSINGH 28TH February 1933 – 30th December 2020

Deonanan "Kenny" Jagdeosingh joined REACT in 1979 when he became a member of REACT Trinidad and Tobago – Team 2496. His first call sign was REACT 631, and later became REACT 103 when a renumbering took place. He was fondly called Apple by his radio friends. He was a family man, public servant, entrepreneur, sporting enthusiast, and volunteer among many other roles.

Kenny was certainly a stalwart *REACT* member making a momunental contribution both at home and on the International arena. In fact, though ill, he did work for *REACT* up to the day just before his passing, as he would have it no other way. That is how committed he was, and therefore earned the respect of all. He led the organization through many trials and tribulations as was a powerful administrator. Some of his accomplishments include transitioning *REACT* from CB radio to VHF/LMR radio, obtaining a Headquarters building, hosting of an International Convention, formation of a Council and being the first person outside of North America to serve on the Board of *REACT* International, Inc.

Kenny was elected to various positions over the years, including Director Region 9, Chairman of the Board of *REACT* TnT, Director Administration, Director Junior *REACT*, Director Public Relations, Council President, and up to his passing, President of *REACT* Trinidad and Tobago - Team 2496, Communications Officer of the *REACT* Trinidad and Tobago Council, and Net Manager for the VHF Radio and Zello Voice Over IP Networks.

Kenny has also received many awards and accolades, but most noteworthy, he was the recipient of the highest *REACT* award that a member can attain, the Eugene S. Goebel award in 2014. He was also the recipient of a National Award – the Hummingbird Medal – Silver in 2011, the *REACT* organization itself also having been similarly recognized in 2014.



May he Rest In Peace.




Virtual Training Conference – Call for Papers

If your answer is yes to these two questions, then please consider volunteering to make a presentation at one of the upcoming Virtual Training Conferences coming up in 2021.




This column, as well as that of other writers such as Kirk Paxson, our hard-working Training Coordinator, have repeatedly emphasized the importance of training and development for *REACT* Teams and membership.

The author has also advocated for the use of virtual technologies to facilitate REACT activities, not only meetings but also to conduct training, especially with the restrictions brought about the COVID-19 pandemic. Apart from the highly recommended courses listed at the back of the REACT ID Card, such as the various FEMA NIMS /Incident Command System (ICS) courses, Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), Skywarn and Emergency Communications (Emcomms) training, REACT offers at least seventeen (17) courses with certification via the website https://reactintl.org/training/.

While self-study courses are great and convenient, sometimes it helps to have an experienced instructor take us through the material or provide an introduction on how to approach the subject of interest. Recently a sixteen (16) session Amateur Radio Technician Class course was facilitated via Zoom and YouTube, with all of the video

recordings available for playback at http://tech.ttreact.com/.

Regarding the upcoming Virtual Training Conferences, the proposed format consists of ½ day events with presenters facilitating various topics of interest. Each module should be 15-30 minutes duration. This is where we are looking for volunteers. Presenters do not have to be *REACT* members, so if you know of anyone that would be interested in making a presentation, please feel free to ask them.
