



## Virtual Amateur Radio Training Course – Technician Class - Completed

A virtual amateur radio training course, Technician Class (2022-2026 Syllabus), was held between April and July 2023. Sessions were held on Friday evenings at 8:30 pm (UTC-4), with each session being approximately 1 hour duration, for a total of 16 sessions.

There was a total of 495 participants from around the world, including the USA, Canada, Trinidad and Tobago, St. Lucia, Barbados, Ecuador, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, St. Kitts and Nevis, Dominica, British Virgin Islands, India, Aruba, Bangladesh, Guyana, and the Cayman Islands.


The General Class course will commence shortly and will be announced here in The *REACT*er as well as via the *REACT* Radiogram.


